All of the councils in District 2 have just concluded or are planning major upcoming events. Councl 1137 at St. John the Baptist Church in Chico will be holding their annual Crab Feed the evening of Saturday, February 10 (traditionally the evening before the Super Bowl). Council 7773 at St. Thomas More Church in Paradise just completed erecting over sixty flags along the Skyway on Veteran's Day, and are currently involved with the construction of a new Social Hall replacing the one that burned in the Camp Fire in 2018. Council 9135 at Immaculate Conception Church in Corning just participated in the annual Corning Olive Festival and has begun hosting monthly Corn Hole tournaments in the Parish Hall. The next one will be December 17 at 3:00 PM. The entry fee is \$20 with half going to the winner's purse. Council 13765 at Our Divine Savior Church in Chico just concluded a successful Harvest Festival netting approximately \$1,300 for the parish youth Group. Councils 1137 and 13765 are collaborating to begin the COR "Men of the Word" Bible Study Program. The first meeting will be on January 16 at 7:00 PM in Room 2 of the ODS Parish Social Hall.
