

Cor (Latin for heart) is intended to "form and strengthen Catholic men in faith and virtue as missionary disciples by drawing them into a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ through, prayer, formation, and fraternaty." Built on the theme "Cor Ecclesiae" the program is designed for use in Catholic men's ministry, particularly in a group study. The Feast Day of The Blessed Michael McGivney falls on Sunday, August 13. Not coincidentally, his feast day falls between his birthday on August 12 (1852) and the day of his death due to complications from tuburcolosis on August 14 (1890). Please plan a special event or prayer reflection to honor our Founder on his Feast Day, August 13. If you are not already a Blessed Michael McGivney Guild member, join online for free at **www.fathermcgivney.org** and begin receiving a monthly newsletter with the latest news on the beatification of our Founder. A third miracle is currently being documented which may advance Blessed McGivney to sainthood. Watch for further information on this remarkable occurrence.

Another program with a long history of charitable service is **the Annual Campaign for People With Intellectual Disabilities**. Although not ocurring until October, it is never to soon to start planning.
