

MEDITATION OF THE DAY Sustained by the Presence of God Alone within it. In turn it remains so present to him, in beautiful simplicity, that he guards it with a jealous care. Then disturbances from without and tempests from within may arise. Its self-esteem may be wounded. God may hide himself, withdraw his sensible grace.... [But] then the Master is free, free to flow into the soul, to give himself according to his measure.... **In him we were also chosen**, destined in accord with the purpose of the One who accomplishes all things according to the intention of his will, so that we might exist for the praise of his glory (Eph 1:11-12). It is Saint Paul who announces to us this divine election, Saint Paul who penetrated so deeply the mystery hidden from ages past in God (Eph 3:9). Then he gives us light on this vocation to which we are called. God, he says, chose us in him, before the foundation of the world, to be holy and without blemish before him (Eph 1:4).... In order to fulfill worthily my work of [praising God], I must remain in the presence of God through everything. It is contact with the divine Being that will make me holy and without blemish in his eyes.

I relate all this to the beautiful virtue of simplicity, [which gives us] rest in God... prelude and echo of the eternal sabbath of which Saint Paul spoke when he said, we then who have believed shall enter into this rest (Heb 4:3). The glorified have this repose because they contemplate God.... They know him, says Saint Paul again, as they are known by him (1 Cor 13:12), that is, by intuitive vision, a simple gaze. And that is why, the great saint continues, they are transformed from brightness to brightness into his very image by the power of his Spirit (2 Cor 3:18). Then they are an unceasing praise of glory of the divine Being.—Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity.

Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity († 1906) was a French Carmelite nun whose writings focused on the indwelling of the Trinity. ¡Bienvenido a Julio! Este mes nos dedicamos a la Preciosísima Sangre de Nuestro Señor.

Al igual que las Sagradas Llagas de Jesús, Su Preciosa Sangre merece especial honor por su estrecha relación con la Sagrada Pasión. Ese honor le fue dado desde el principio por los Apóstoles que alabaron su poder redentor. (Romanos 5:9 "somos justificados en su sangre"; Hebreos 13:12 "y así también Jesús, para santificar al pueblo en su sangre, padeció fuera de la puerta"; 1 Juan 1:7 "y la sangre de Jesucristo, su Hijo, nos limpia de todo pecado.")

El Papa Benedicto XVI, en su audiencia del Ángelus del 5 de julio de 2009, recordó a los fieles que el primer domingo de julio ha sido tradicionalmente un momento de devoción a la Preciosísima Sangre de Cristo. Esa tradición fue firmemente respaldada por el Papa Juan XXIII, recordó. El Papa prosiguió hablando de la "sangre de la alianza", señalando que se trata de un tema "de primordial importancia en la Sagrada Escritura".

La Sangre de Cristo es fuente de salvación, dice el Papa a las comunidades de la Preciosa Sangre. A la luz de la devoción de julio a la Preciosa Sangre, el 30 de junio de 2018, el Papa Francisco se dirigió a los miembros de los Misioneros de la Preciosa Sangre y otras comunidades fundadas o inspiradas por San Gaspar del Búfalo (1786-1837). "Dios ha elegido el signo de la sangre, porque ningún otro signo es tan elocuente para expresar el supremo amor a la vida entregada a los demás", afirmó el Papa, antes de reflexionar sobre "la valentía de la verdad, la atención a todos, especialmente a los más lejanos", y la capacidad de fascinar y comunicar". Welcome to July! This month we devote ourselves to the Most Precious Blood of Our Lord. Like the Sacred Wounds of Jesus, His Precious Blood deserves special honor because of its close relation to the Sacred Passion. That honor was given to it from the beginning by the Apostles who

praised its redeeming power. (Romans 5:9 "we are justified by His blood"; Heb. 13:12 "and so Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people by His blood, suffered outside the gate"; 1 John 1:7 "and the blood of Jesus Christ, His Son, cleanses us from all sin.")

Pope Benedict XVI, at his Angelus audience on July 5, 2009, reminded the faithful that the first Sunday in July has traditionally been a time for devotions to the Most Precious Blood of Christ. That tradition was strongly endorsed by Pope John XXIII, he recalled. The Pope went on to speak about the "blood of the covenant," noting that this is a theme "of primary importance in Sacred Scripture."

Christ's Blood is the source of salvation, Pope tells Precious Blood communities. In light of July's devotion to the Precious Blood, on June 30, 2018, Pope Francis addressed members of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood and other communities founded or inspired by St. Gaspar del Bufalo (1786-1837). "God chose the sign of blood, because no other sign is so eloquent to express the supreme love of life given for others," the Pope said, before reflecting on "the courage of the truth, attention to all, especially to the most distant, and the ability to fascinate and to communicate."
