

expresses theologically the same mysterious reality that Jesus presented to his disciples shortly before offering his life in redemption for mankind. Portrayed majestically by Matthew in chapter 25 of his Gospel, Jesus tells us that each thing we have done, or have not done, to each of the least of our brothers and sisters, we will have done, or will not have done, to him (Mt 25:31-46). Therefore, the last judgement issued on our life will be based on love.

Indeed, we ourselves shall reveal the naked truth of our reality to all when we appear before God's presence. This is the heart of Christian life: charity, mercy, and acceptance. At the sunset of our life, all that will remain is that particle of love that we have placed in each thing. There is, however, another side to this coin: besides being judged on love, we shall also be judged by Love, that is, by God...Each man who seeks repentance and pardon is given the hope that no sin, no situation in life & no human failure can be excluded from God's love....

The enemy of the human race, who rebelled against God & who intends to bring all creation to perdition and destruction, also wishes to make us lose the hope of love and joy in each moment of our lives, including the final moment, when through God's mercy we shall have restored to us the possibility of redeeming ourselves, after having been separated by original sin from total communion with the Creator. The devil, through his extraordinary action...tries to destroy the confidence of each man and each woman to love and to be loved. [But may our hearts be filled] with the hope that is based on the rock, the Word of God, that neither rain, nor the overflowing of rivers, nor the blowing of violent winds—nor any other dramatic experience from which we could borrow metaphors—can destroy. — FATHER GABRIELE AMORTH



¡Bienvenidos a junio! Este mes está dedicado al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. El Corazón de Jesús; Símbolo de amor. ¿Pero por qué Su Corazón?

Porque en todos los idiomas, en todas las épocas, el corazón es considerado el símbolo natural del amor y del afecto. ¿Qué símbolo más natural y expresivo hay, entonces, del amor excesivo de Jesús que su Sagrado Corazón?



Welcome to June! This month is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Heart of Jesus; Symbol of Love. But why His Heart?

Because in every language, in every age, the heart is regarded as the natural symbol of love and affection. What more natural and expressive symbol is there, then, of the excessive love of Jesus than His Sacred Heart?

La devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús es devoción al mismo Jesucristo, pero en los modos particulares de meditar en Su vida interior y en Su triple amor – Su amor divino; Su amor ardiente que alimentó Su voluntad humana; y su amor sensible que afecta su vida interior. A continuación se presentan algunos extractos de la encíclica de 1956 del Papa Pío XII, *Haurietis Aquas* (Sobre la devoción al Sagrado Corazón), que ayudan a explicar la devoción:

- ☞ ...el Corazón del Verbo Encarnado es merecidamente y con razón considerado el principal signo y símbolo de ese triple amor con el que el divino Redentor ama incesantemente a su Padre eterno y a toda la humanidad.
- ☞ Es símbolo de ese amor divino que comparte con el Padre y el Espíritu Santo pero que sólo Él, el Verbo hecho carne, manifiesta a través de un cuerpo débil y perecedero, ya que "en Él habita corporalmente la plenitud de la Deidad".
- ☞ Es, además, el símbolo de ese amor ardiente que, infundido en su alma, enriquece la voluntad humana de Cristo e ilumina y gobierna sus actos con el conocimiento más perfecto que se deriva tanto de la visión beatífica como de la directamente infundida.
- ☞ Y finalmente – y esto de manera más natural y directa – es el símbolo también del amor sensible, ya que el cuerpo de Jesucristo, formado por el Espíritu Santo en el seno de la Virgen María, posee plenos poderes de sentimiento y de percepción, de hecho, más que cualquier otro cuerpo humano.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is devotion to Jesus Christ Himself, but in the particular ways of meditating on His interior life and on His threefold love – His divine love; His burning love that fed His human will; and His sensible love that affects His interior life. Below are a few excerpts from the 1956 encyclical of Pope Pius XII, *Haurietis Aquas* (On Devotion To The Sacred Heart), which help explain the devotion:

- ☞ ...the Heart of the Incarnate Word is deservedly and rightly considered the chief sign & symbol of that threefold love with which the divine Redeemer unceasingly loves His eternal Father and all mankind.
- ☞ It is a symbol of that divine love which He shares with the Father and the Holy Spirit but which He, the Word made flesh, alone manifests thru a weak and perishable body, since "in Him dwells the fullness of the Godhead bodily."
- ☞ It is, besides, the symbol of that burning love which, infused into His soul, enriches the human will of Christ and enlightens and governs its acts by the most perfect knowledge derived both from the beatific vision and that which is directly infused.
- ☞ And finally – and this in a more natural and direct way – it is the symbol also of sensible love, since the body of Jesus Christ, formed by the Holy Spirit in the womb of the Virgin Mary, possesses full powers of feelings and perception, in fact, more so than any other human body.

ST. GERTRUDE PRAYER TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, fountain of eternal life, Your Heart is a glowing furnace of love. You are my refuge and my sanctuary. O my adorable & loving Savior, consume my heat with the burning fire with which Yours is inflamed. Pour down on my soul those graces which flow from Your love. Let my heart be united with Yours. Let my will be conformed to Yours in all things. May Your Will be the rule of all my desires and actions. Amen.
