

GRAND KNIGHT'S NOTATIONS

Is it global warming and climate change, the natural weather cycle, or just another everyday catastrophic Earth event? On August 8, 2023 a very familiar catastrophic event, similar to the Paradise, Camp Fire of November 8, 2018, destroyed the town of Lahaina, Hawaii. There were so many similarities: high winds, no evacuation notices, hydrants without water. It was a replay of the events that we went through during the Camp Fire.

Greg Kidder made calls to Maui and contacted St. Anthony's Catholic Church, the temporary home office of Maria Lanakila Catholic Church in Lahaina in preparation to support the parishioners of Lahaina. The Maria Lanakila Catholic Church had smoke damage and their rectory was damaged along with the school. Greg was able to obtain a point of contact, and he coordinated help for them. He also found out that they needed to develop a strategy on how we can help them the best.

St. Thomas More Parishioners wrote handwritten words of encouragement to the people of Lahaina. It was the intent to share our struggles and provide comfort to the people Lahaina, said Greg. Home-Tech Charter School's (Paradise Outreach Program) Ms. Danielle DiPietro Hawkins also participated by having her students prepare cards and artwork that will be sent together with our parishioners. We are hoping our words of encouragement will help the parishioners of Maria Lanakila Church and the people of Lahaina, said Ms. Hawkins.

There was an overwhelming response at the Knights Meeting to donate funds to the local Catholic Church on Maui. Without hesitation, a vote was made to support the church in Maui. Greg had an additional collection at our church in support of the people of Lahaina, and the Knights DJ Lemire, with daughter Claire, and John Thomas barbequed pork chops with applesauce along with John's homemade baked beans for after church luncheon to benefit Lahaina. Greg DC prepped the luncheon, and, along with Kathy and several Knights, helped with cleanup. It was a nice event to support the families in Hawaii.
